Needs

Pre-class Preparation

Bring your scraps sorted into colours and well ironed. In class we'll cut them into varying widths and start preparing your blocks. Choose a colour range and one main colour you think works well with all of them. In the class sample I chose white as a main colour but my 'whites' are a messy collection of all my white-on-white printed scraps, off-whites and creams from over the years. So, your main colour can be made up of blenders as long as it 'reads' as one main colour to unify your colour palette of scraps.

In class we'll make a sample to practice matchstick quilting. This will give you the confidence to go home and make a quilt to any dimension you like. You can use your 'sample' later to become a cushion or pillow sham, so bring a piece of batting offcut and some backing fabric the size of your intended cushion or sham plus 2 inches all round. The backing fabric won't be seen and will be inside the cushion so use some left-over fabric. I use my stash of worn-out cotton sheets as backings.

If you have scraps you'd like to clear out, feel free to bring them and swap for the colours you need.

Supplies

- Thread – in your main colour
- Long ruler and rotary cutter (with a fresh blade)
- Cutting mat
- Scissors
- Pins or binding clips if you have them
- Frixion pen, or your choice of marker



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- Batting off-cut
- Some cotton backing fabric bigger than the batting (see notes)
- Lots of scraps, any size, sorted into colours, ironed

Needs

Pre-class Preparation

Learn to sew curves in this class, progressing from the simplest of blocks to more complex shapes to create the leaf and petal variations. The class includes a full pattern, and we will be creating our own templates during the class so you'll be able to complete all the variations. Bring a piece of batting off-cut and some cotton batting to practice matchstick quilting and creating curves.

The sample quilt is in shades of pink, red and orange with white base and green leaves but choose which every colours you like for your quilt or the background colour. Use google images to explore the infinite variations.

Supplies

- Thread – in your main colours
- Ruler and rotary cutter (with a fresh blade)
- Cutting mat
- Scissors
- Pins
- Frixion pen, or your choice of marker
- Batting off-cut
- Some cotton backing fabric bigger than the batting (see notes)
- A mix of fabrics in your colour pallet – include two tones or blenders of each colour
- Background colour
- Green shades for leaves – pick more than one colour
- Plastic template material – I use think plastic cutting boards from the \$2 shop at
