## Class Description

These stylish backpacks have secure zippered closures and plenty of pockets to keep everything neat yet easy to access.

A padded handle and adjustable straps make them easy to carry and wear.

Choose the size you prefer: Back At Ya 2.1, a mini backpack, or Got Your Back 2.1, a larger pack. See the pattern covers attached for more info about sizes and features of each.

Learn easy techniques for quilting with Soft and Stable, installing zippers, making sturdy straps, and finishing with beautiful bindings as you make these sturdy and useful backpack purses.

## Class Supply List

In this class you may make *either* the Back At Ya mini backpack *or* the Got Your Back backpack. You will need the following supplies in class:

- Back At Ya 2.1 pattern or Got Your Back 2.1 pattern** — pattern must be purchased BEFORE class so that student may gather supplies, cut out and quilt fabrics.
- All fabrics and supplies as listed on pattern cover (see next page)**

## ALSO BRING TO CLASS

- Sewing machine in good working order with walking foot, 1/4" foot, and zipper foot. Don't forget the extension table for your machine.
- Rotary cutter and rulers
- Basic sewing kit, including #90/14 topstitch needles, Wonder Clips, ByAnnie's stiletto/pressing tool, pins (we like using extra-fine silk pins as well as the large yellow-topped quilting pins), scissors, thread, chalk marker or similar tool for marking lines, washable school glue stick, bodkin or large safety pin, turning tool, etc.

## BEFORE CLASS

- To make best use of class time, please complete all of step **I. CUT AND QUILT** on pages 2-3 of the pattern *BEFORE* coming to class.
  - a. Begin by gathering the supplies for your project.
  - b. Then cut out the fabrics, Soft and Stable, mesh, interfacing, and strapping, being sure to attach labels to all pieces as you cut.
  - c. Then quilt the appropriate pieces, cut out and label pieces from the quilted fabric, and seal their edges.

<b>Mesh fabric</b> <sup>*</sup> (inner zippered pocket) SUP209 or <b>Contrasting fabric</b> (inner zippered pocket)	13" x 11" of mesh or ½ yard of fabric
<b>Fusible interfacing</b> <sup>*</sup> SUP179	½ yard
<b>1" polypro strapping</b> <sup>*</sup> SUP164-1	2½ yards
<b>Handbag zippers</b> <sup>*</sup> to match fabrics ZIP30	Two 30" double-slide zippers
<b>TIP:</b> Two 30" double-slide zippers will make the two 15" single-slide and the 24" double-slide zippers needed for this project.

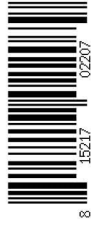

<b>Mesh fabric</b> (inner zippered pocket) SUP209 or <b>Contrasting fabric</b> (inner zippered pocket)	15" x 14" of mesh or ⅓ yard of fabric
<b>Fusible interfacing</b> <sup>*</sup> SUP179	¾ yard
<b>1" polypro strapping</b> <sup>*</sup> SUP164-1	2½ yards
<b>Handbag zippers</b> <sup>*</sup> to match fabrics ZIP30	Two 30" double-slide zippers
<b>TIP:</b> Two 30" double-slide zippers will make the 14" and 16" single-slide and 24" double-slide zippers needed for this project.

## Class Description

Functional, yet stylish, this sturdy duffle bag carries everything you need for a weekend trip — and easily fits in the overhead bin or under the forward seat. The bag measures 16"L x 10"H x 7"D.

The full-zippered top allows easy access to all your gear. A comfortable padded adjustable carrying strap and quick-grab side handles make it convenient for all sorts of travel.

With one zippered and four slip pockets on the outside and three more slip pockets inside, the bag will keep everything organized and close at hand.

## Class Supply List

- Get Out of Town pattern**
- Fabric and supplies\* as listed on pattern back cover**  
  
**\*Finishing kits with hardware, strapping, interfacing and zippers are available.**
- Thread to match fabrics**
  - I recommend SoFine 50 a 50 wt. spun polyester thread from Superior Threads for this project.

## ALSO BRING TO CLASS:

- Sewing machine in good working order with walking foot, 1/4" foot, and zipper foot. Don't forget the extension table for your machine.
- Rotary cutter and rulers
- Basic sewing kit, including #90/14 topstitch needles, Wonder Clips, a stiletto/pressing tool, pins (the large yellow-topped quilting pins work best), scissors, thread, chalk marker or similar tool for marking lines, etc.

## BEFORE CLASS:

To make best use of class time, please cut out and quilt the pieces for the project according to the Cutting & Quilting Instructions on page 2 of the pattern. From the quilted fabric, cut out the pieces for the bag as directed in Step A (1) on page 2 of the pattern BEFORE coming to class.

## GET OUT OF TOWN DUFFLE



This functional yet stylish dufflebag has two styles of handles including grab handles on the side and a detachable, adjustable strap with pad for comfortable over-the-shoulder carrying.

One zippered and four slip pockets on the outside plus three more slip pockets inside provide plenty of organized storage.

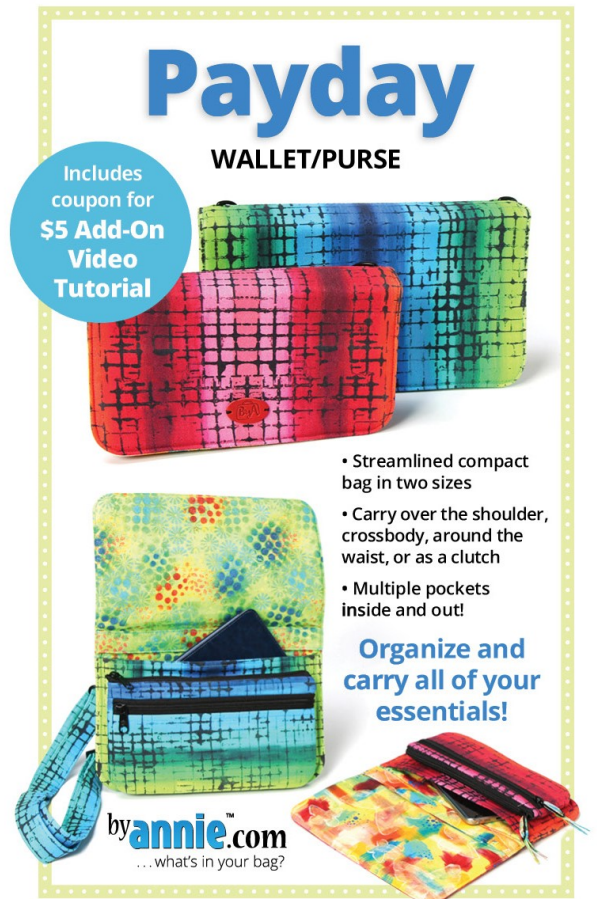

- Basic sewing kit, including #90/14 topstitch needles, Wonder Clips, a stiletto/pressing tool, pins (we like the extra-fine silk pins as well as the large yellow-topped quilting pins), scissors, thread to match fabrics, chalk marker or similar tool for marking lines, washable school glue stick, bodkin or safety pin, turning tool, etc.

## Handbag zippers\* ZIP24, ZIP30, ZIPYD

To make the small (large) wallet, you will need a minimum of 30" (36") of zipper tape and 2 pulls to make:

Pocket B closure: one side of a 20" (24") single-slide zipper	One 30" or longer double-slide zipper	One 40" or longer double-slide zipper
Pocket A closure: 10" (12") single-slide zipper

Learn easy techniques for quilting with Soft and Stable, sewing with mesh and vinyl, installing zippers, and binding as you make the case.

## Class Supply List

In this class we will make the *Running With Scissors* tool case. You will need the following supplies in class:

- Running With Scissors pattern**
- All fabric and supplies listed on back cover of pattern** including ByAnnie's Soft and Stable, mesh, vinyl, strapping, foldover elastic and handbag zippers.

*TIP: We also recommend the companion pattern Take A Stand (sold separately) for totes in two sizes specially designed to use as a base on which to prop the case for easy access or to carry the case and more.*

## ALSO BRING TO CLASS

- Sewing machine in good working order with walking foot, 1/4" foot, and zipper foot. If you have a Teflon foot for your machine, bring it, too, to facilitate stitching on the vinyl. Don't forget the extension table for your machine.
- Rotary cutter and rulers
- Basic sewing kit, including #90/14 topstitch needles, Wonder Clips, a stiletto/pressing tool, pins (the large yellow-topped quilting pins work best), scissors, thread, chalk marker or similar tool for marking lines, washable school glue stick, etc.

To make best use of class time, please cut out everything for the project and quilt (and cut) the appropriate pieces according to the instructions on page 2 of the pattern **BEFORE** coming to class. Please complete everything in step **I. CUT AND QUILT**.

Each tote features an adjustable, detachable carrying strap plus two outer zippered pockets and two inner mesh pockets.

Learn easy techniques for quilting with Soft and Stable, sewing with mesh, installing zippers, and binding as you make the tote.

## Class Supply List

In this class you will make either the small or the large *Take A Stand* tote. You will need the following supplies in class:

- Take A Stand pattern**
- All fabric and supplies listed on back cover of pattern** including ByAnnie's Soft and Stable, mesh, strapping, foldover elastic, and handbag zippers.

*TIP: We also recommend the companion pattern *Running With Scissors* (sold separately) for a handy tool case designed to be used with these totes.*

## ALSO BRING TO CLASS

- Sewing machine in good working order with walking foot, 1/4" foot, and zipper foot. Don't forget the extension table for your machine.
- Rotary cutter and rulers
- Basic sewing kit, including #90/14 topstitch needles, Wonder Clips, a stiletto/pressing tool, pins (we like the extra-fine silk pins as well as the large yellow-topped quilting pins), scissors, thread to match fabrics, chalk marker or similar tool for marking lines, washable school glue stick, bodkin or safety pin, turning tool, etc.

## BEFORE CLASS
