#### Needs

#### **Supplies**

Needles, scissors, cutting mat and rotary cutter etc

Thread to match or complement the colour of your fabrics

#### Kit Includes or Bring Your Own

- 1 ½ metres Main feature window fabric
- 1 m background fabric
- 1.25m window frame fabric

Fabric requirements are for one feature fabric however you could use scraps for this and have a different border. If choosing this then you will need scraps for windows to be 4 inch square.

## **Key Details**

• Sewing Machine Not Required

#### **Provided by Tutor**

- Different types of paints for use in the class
- Shiva sticks, inktense pencils and blocks
- Fabric pack as a base for surface design. These will include white and pre-dyed fabric (Equivalent to 7 fat quarters)
- Stencils, stamps and other objects for surface design

## Needs

#### Supplies

- Apron or old clothes in case you get paint on these
- Rubber gloves (I prefer disposable fitting gloves and will have some on hand if you want to try these)
- Paint tray and roller you get these from Mitre10, Bunnings or your local hardware store. You need a small tray that comes with a handle and two foam rollers (cost about \$12 - \$15)
- If you have dyed fabric you would like to use as well feel free to bring it along
- Any stamps/ stencils or objects you would like to play with (optional as I will have plenty)
- An old towel or padded surface (makes the stamping more effective to have some give in the surface)

# **Slow Stitch Scroll**

## **Key Details**

- Sewing Machine
- Optional Kit

## Needs

#### **Supplies**

- Needles, scissors, cutting mat and rotary cutter etc
- Thread to match or complement the colour of your scroll
- Hand sewing needles I use a Chenille needle usually but have a variety of sizes on hand to work with different thicknesses of thread. The eye of the needle must be big enough to accommodate the thread and have a sharp point on it.

#### **Kit Includes**

- 6 small pieces of hand printed coordinated fabric
- 3 x Embroidery Threads to go coordinate with fabrics
- Fused applique shapes
- A length of batting approx. 40 in x 4 in
- Backing material approx. size of batting

#### **Bring Your Own**

- 6 Scraps of fabric to stitch on that are all approx. 10 in x 4 in
- A selection of embroidery threads
- Small scraps of fabric to fuse or stitch onto scroll
- Small amount of fusible webbing
- Batting to match size of scroll you want to make
- Backing material approx. size of batting

# **Slow Stitch Scroll**

You can also bring a selection of buttons, beads, scraps of material to add to your scroll (optional). You can always add these later when finishing your piece at home.

Bring along any extra threads you may have to play with and add to your bits and pieces or to the kit if used.

Remember that you only need little bits and pieces of fabric and fusing for adding shapes to your scroll. Leftover scraps are good.

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
