Key Details

- Sewing Machine Not Required
- Includes Materials Hand Turned Native Timber Wooden Bowl

Needs

Supplies

- 1 fat quarter of a plain loose weave fabric such as linen
- 1 skein of sashiko cotton
- A few skeins of embroidery thread
- Sashiko needle or chenille needle size 22.
- Fabric scissors
- Fabric marker suitable for your fabric
- Pencil and notepad
- Small amount of wool or polyester stuffing (enough to fill a coffee cup)
- A ruler

- Includes Materials 2 Balls, Gold and Silver Thread,

Needs

Supplies

- A spool or cone of cheap thread ie over locker thread in a background colour
- 3 shades of Pearl 5 Cotton within one colour family (ie 3 shades of pink)
- Any other skeins Pearl 5 cotton you wish to bring.
- Darning needles
- Pearl headed pins (pins with big tops)
- Scissors
- Notebook and pencil

- Includes Materials Some Coloured Papers, Paper for pages, Thread, Glue and Card will be provided.

Needs

Supplies

- 1 fat quarter of quilting fabric
- 1/4 meter of fusible webbing
- Paper scissors
- Glue stick
- Craft Knife with snap off blades
- Steel ruler (if you have one) or plastic ruler
- Small Cutting mat (if you have one)
- Embroidery threads
- Darning needle
- Papers (these are covered by the materials fee)
- For the covers (covered by materials fee but you are welcome to bring your own) If you have old calenders, hand made papers, nice paper bags, prints, wallpaper, wrapping paper, old maps that you want to use for covers please bring them.
- A knife with a smooth handle, or a plastic kiwifruit knife/spoon, or a bone folder (if you already have one).
- I have a few spare knives, and bone folders if required.

- You will be able to buy sashiko thread and needles from merchants at the symposium.

Needs

Supplies

Fabric scissors
Needles
Pins
Unpicker
Fabric pencil (for marking a grid)
Pencil sharpener
Ruler and cutting mat
Sashiko needles (the shorter ones) or Chenille needles (chenille 22) that work with
your chosen thread
Sashiko thread or Perle cotton 5 in chosen colour, embroidery threads
Your glasses if you need them

Half metre of chosen fabric which doesn't have too tight a weave (ie not batik as it is hard to hand stitch through) – I suggest a plain medium weight linen or Homespun.
If you want to do Hitomizashi (one stitch sashiko). To save having to mark your fabric in a grid you can buy premarked dot fabric by Olympus. This is called 'Just Dots' and is available in quilt shops.
