Key Details

- Sewing Machine Required with Quarter Inch Foot (Guide Optional)

Needs

Supplies

- Block Pattern Fabrics:**
- Half a metre of a multi-coloured fabric
- Three fat-quarters of coordinating fabrics, (all 100% cotton pre washed and ironed).
- Background Fabric :**
- 1 metre of well washed calico, homespun or similar.

- Neutral thread either cream, light beige, grey or khaki
- Quilter rulers 24 inch long and 6 or 8 inch square
- A fine Bic mechanical pencil or similar and notebook
- Usual sewing equipment, unpick, pins, scissors etc

- Sewing Machine Required with Free-Motion Foot
- Includes Fee for Notes

Needs

Supplies

Bird and leaf fabrics MUST be batik, for branches and backgrounds this is optional.

- 2 pieces of fabric 20 x 18 , one for the background and one for lining
- 20 x 18 piece of batting
- 10 x 12 (one inch deep) artist canvas - this size for this class is mandatory
- 12 x 12 fusible- (the 'sticky' variety is more complicated to use in this class)
- 8 to 10 pieces of batik fabric in desired colourway 6" square or smaller - scraps work well for this as some pieces will be quite small.
- 3 x 3 grey or brown batik - for feet and beak
- 4 x 12 inch brown fabric - for branches
- 3 x 12 inch strips med green batik fabric- for leaves
- 3 x 12 inch strip light green batik
- Good small sharp scissors
- Black thread
- Mechanical pencil

I provide light tables, special baking paper and staple guns/staples for students.

Needs

Supplies

- One piece of dark fabric (strongly recommend black or dark blue) for background. 20 inch square minimum size.
- An assortment of bright BATIK fabric squares. Tone on tone or solid recommended. Pieces three to ten inches. An ambitious quilter might use twenty shades. Most will need no more than eight colours in a variety of sizes. Scraps work well for this project.
- Dark threads, needles, etc.
- Small sharp pointed scissors.
- Small ruler (school ruler would work fine)
- Enough Steam a seam (or similar) to adhere the squares brought
- Make sure the iron-on has a paper backing as this is essential.
- Mechanical pencil and eraser
- Small sharp exacto type knife/razor
- White iron away pen (made by clover)

Fabrics must work well together, trial them on the background to make sure there is enough contrast for them to be visible. Surprisingly even medium dark purples, browns, blues and greens often won't be visible on a dark background.
