Key Details

- Sewing Machine Required
- Includes Workbook

Needs

Supplies

- Sewing machine with lots of decorative stitches to choose from
- Machine extension table
- 1/4" Foot
- Open toe Embroidery Foot
- Free Motion open toe foot
- 1 x reel of White Bobbin Fill thread for bobbin
- Fat quarters of up to 5 solid coloured or low textured fabrics
- 3 x 6-inch squares of eye spy or floral fabric to fussy cut
- 1 metre of white background fabric
- 1.5 metre of strong heavy weight stabilizer

Please precut 4 x A4 size rectangles of both white background fabric and stabilizer and pin together for testing stitches

- 30cms by width of light weight non-fusible interfacing
- 1 meter of Vliesofix or similar brand fusible webbing
- 3 x reels of 50wt. cotton thread colours to work in with your fabrics.
- 1 x reel of Superior threads Mono.Poly thread
- 3 reels of 40 wt. shiny 100% polyester threads (Wonderfil Polyfast or Mettler Polysheen) colours to work in with your fabrics.
- 3 reels of 12 wt. cotton threads (please include white)
- ¼ inch bias maker tool
- 1 x packet of size 90 and 100 topstitch needles.
- Small iron, ironing mat

Crazy Wedge Patchwork By Machine

Key Details

- Sewing Machine Required

Needs

Supplies

- Sewing machine with lots of decorative stitches to choose from
- Machine extension table
- 1/4" Foot
- 1 x Open toe Embroidery Foot
- 1 x reel of White Bobbin Fill thread for bobbin
- Fat quarters of up to 10 solid coloured or low textured fabrics
- 1 x fat ¼ of white homespun fabric
- 1 metre of non-fusible light weight interfacing
- 1 metre of strong heavy weight stabilizer

Please precut 2 x A4 size rectangles of both fabric and stabilizer and pin together for testing stitches

- 1 x neural coloured 50wt. cotton thread for piecing
- 40 wt. shiny 100% polyester threads (Wonderfil Polyfast or Mettler Polysheen) colours to work in with your fabrics, Rayons, metallics, silks etc. a good variety of thread.
- 12 wt. cotton threads to suit your fabrics (please include white)
- 1 x packet of size 100 topstitch needles.
- Small iron, ironing mat or towel
- Rotary cutter with a new blade, small ruler and cutting board at least 30 cms square
- Small sharp scissors, usual sewing needs and please include a quick unpick tool

The Theory of Walking Foot Quilting

Key Details

- Sewing Machine Required
- Includes Workbook

Needs

Supplies

- Sewing Machine in good working order
- Machine extension table if you have one
- Knee lift
- Walking foot
- Open toe embroidery foot
- 2x 50 x 70 cms rectangles of light solid coloured fabric
- 1 x 50 x 70 cms rectangle of batting either wool/polyester, wool/cotton blend or 100% cotton or 100% polyester batting.
- 1 reel of 100% cotton 50 wt. thread Gutermann or other brand thread in a dark colour.
- 1 x reel of 100% cotton 12 weight thread any colour
- Machine needles size 90 topstitch.
- One can of 505 basting spray
- Scissors and usual sewing needs
- Paper Masking tape 2 inches wide
- Pencil, pen and paper for notes
- Quilting Gloves or non-slip mats

A small sample will be made in class with many stitches suitable for quilting your own quilts. The theory of how to quilt your own quilts on a domestic sewing machine will be discussed in detail. You will have the confidence to start quilting your own quilts with the walking foot.
