Key Details

- Sewing Machine Required
- Darning Foot or Free-form Machine Quilting Foot Required

Needs

Supplies

- Flat bed tray for your machine
- Machine Quilting Needles (one mixed packet (75/90) and Top Stitch Needles size 90)
- A variety of suitable machine quilting threads
- Fabric pencil
- Usual sewing equipment (scissors, quick-un-pic,)
- It may also help to bring a cushion to put on your chair
- Quilting gloves for a better grip are suggested
- 100% cotton fabric to work on

Three or four prepared pieces ready to quilt on during class.

I suggest a fat quarter size is best to work on or a little larger. You will need backing and batting for this size. I prefer to use a 80% cotton / 20% polyester batting. Ensure that the backing and batting is a little larger than top piece. These can be safety pinned or glue basted together.

Stellar Beauty Introduction to Foundation Paper Piecing

Key Details

- Sewing Machine Required
- Includes Pattern

Needs

Supplies

- Sewing Machine in good working order
- Flat bed tray for your machine
- Matching thread for sewing seams
- Scissors, both paper and fabric
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
- Pencil and rubber
- Open toed appliqué foot
- 1/4" foot for piecing
- Usual sewing requirements (scissors, quick-un-pic, pins, etc)

I have made this quilt using 8 rainbow colors from my scrap bag.

I have used yellow, orange, pink, pinky purple, purple, blues, turquoise and green.

Therefore, it is difficult to estimate how much exactly you need of each.

- Estimated about a total of 30cms (1/3 yd) of each of these 8 fabrics groups:
 - 25cm for inner circle of the New York Beauty
 - 25cm for corner squares in the border
 - 30cm for stars in two fabrics – one for the centre and one for the points
 - 1m of light background fabric for New York beauty blocks
 - 1m for pieced border
 - 25cms for inner border
 - 40cms for binding

- Scissors, both paper and fabric

- 1/4" foot for piecing
- Usual sewing requirements (scissors, quick-un-pic, pins, etc)

I have used my scrap bags of two contrasting colour groups.

Therefore it's difficult to estimate exactly how much fabric you will need. I estimate I have used about 1m in total of the two colour groups.

- Estimated about a total of 30cms (1/3 yd) of each of these 8 fabrics groups:
 - 1m (1 yd) of light background fabric in foundation piecing
 - 1m (1 yd) for border and contrasting background
 - 40cms (1/2 yd) for binding

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
