	Ruler-preferably around 12"x 6"

5" x 10" of all fabrics:
A light and dark colour for the cup and a lighter contrast for the base
5-8 different floral fabrics you can cut motifs from
5-7 different background fabrics in neutrals and pale pinks. Tone-on-tone fabrics
are best, but use a few smaller printed fabrics.
A comfy pair of medium sized scissors you don't mind cutting paper with, for cutting
motifs.
1m of 24" wide steam-a-seam. (Other fusible webs not suitable)
40cm lightweight non-fusible interfacing or 100% cotton for foundation.
Baking paper or Teflon sheet.
Permanent sharpie pen.
Backing 16" x 16"
Cotton batting 16" x 16"
