Needs

Pattern Prep

Cutting Paper Pieces

The more prep work that takes place BEFORE class, the more sewing and instruction time we will have. However, if you rather wait for class, that is fine as well.

- You may cut out your pattern pieces before class in order to have more sewing time.
 If you choose to cut out the pattern pieces before class, the pattern includes details on how to cut the pattern pieces out.
- If you are feeling optimistic, you can also GLUE together the pieces that have Glue Edges. However, this will be covered in Class.
- I also recommend printing off a SECOND copy of the paper pieces as Back-Up for mistakes or rips or tears.
- Organize the pattern pieces in alphabetical order for quicker access (an office alphabetizer or file folder can help).



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Fabric Prep

Pre-Starching

Whether you decide to select your own fabric or purchase the fabric kit, I recommend starching your fabric ahead of time and giving the fabric a nice iron over. I personally do not pre-wash because Bella Solids are very high quality, However, I do starch all the fabric before I start a sewing project. This will help make the sewing process more successful. DO NOT precut your fabric into fabric shapes.

Thread

You are welcome to bring whatever thread you prefer. My preference is WONDERFIL 80wt DECOBOB in a gray shade. You can also have a look at my complete collection of Threads called "Joy of Creation."
